

Motion for the constitution of the Interest Group for Bibliographic Standards

We herewith propose that a national LIASA interest group, the *Interest Group for Bibliographic Standards (IGBIS)* be constituted, to promote and facilitate the application of bibliographic standards within the profession.

The objectives of IGBIS are as follows:

- 1 to support and promote the aim and objectives of LIASA;
- 2 to support and promote the aim and objectives of IGBIS at branch level;
- 3 to promote standardisation in bibliographic work nationally amongst a united group of library and information workers, and other interested parties;
- 4 to provide for the exchange of ideas and experiences in regard to the application of bibliographic standards among members;
- 5 to address issues which affect the application of bibliographic standards;
- 6 to identify training needs in respect of bibliographic standards;
- 7 to conduct continuing education for information workers by organising talks, meetings and workshops;
- 8 to support academics, researchers, students and the community through the provision of information about bibliographic standards.

IGBIS would operate under the umbrella of LIASA and hope to serve as a forum for alignment of bibliographic standardisation within South Africa.
